PRAYER OVER THE FIRE (in the Courtyard)

Officiant

Dear friends in Christ: On this most holy night, in which our Lord Jesus passed over from death to life, the Church invites her members, dispersed throughout the world, to gather in vigil and prayer. For this is the Passover of the Lord, in which, by hearing his Word and celebrating his Sacraments, we share in his victory over death.

Eternal God, who made this most holy night to shine with the brightness of your one true light: sanctify this new fire, we pray, and so set us aflame with the fire of your love, that with pure hearts and kindled affections we may attain to the radiance of your heavenly glory; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

LIGHTING OF THE PASCHAL CANDLE (The people stand)

Officiant

May the light of Christ, rising in glory, banish all darkness from our hearts and minds.

The procession carries the Paschal Candle, signifying the Light of Christ, into the Nave, pausing three times and singing:

He casts out pride and hatred, and brings peace and concord. How blessed is your Son, in whom earth and heaven are joined and man is reconciled to God.

THE PRESENTATION

Officiant: The Candidates for Holy Baptism will now be presented.

I present [NAME] to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.

The Celebrant asks Candidates the following:
Officiant: Have you already been baptized?

PROFESSION OF FAITH

Officiant: Candidates, do you renounce the Devil and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God?

Candidates: I renounce them.

Officiant: Do you renounce the empty promises and deadly deceits of this world which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God?

Candidates: I renounce them.

Officiant: Do you renounce the sinful desires of the flesh that draw you from the love of God?

Candidates: I renounce them.

Officiant to the Candidate: Almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness and evil, and lead you into the light and obedience of the Kingdom of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Officiant: Do you turn to Jesus Christ and confess Him as your Lord and Savior? Candidates: I do.

Officiant Do you joyfully receive the Christian Faith, as revealed in the Holy Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments?

Candidates: I do.

Officiant: Will you obediently keep God's holy will and commandments, and walk in them all the days of your life?

Candidates: I will, the Lord being my helper.

Please stand.

Officiant to Congregation: Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support these children in their life in Christ?

Congregation: We will.

THE APOSTLES' CREED

Celebrant Let us join together to proclaim our faith in the words of the ancient baptismal confession, the Apostles' Creed.

Do you believe and trust in God the Father?

All: I do.

I believe in God the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Celebrant Do you believe and trust in Jesus Christ?

All: I do.

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried: He descended to the dead. On the third day He rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

Celebrant: Do you believe and trust in the Holy Spirit?

All: I do.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

PRAYERS FOR THE CANDIDATES

Celebrant: Let us pray.

Almighty and everlasting Father, in your great mercy You saved Noah and his family in the Ark from the destruction of the flood, prefiguring the sacrament of Holy Baptism. Look mercifully upon these your servants. Wash and sanctify them through your Holy Spirit, that they may be delivered from destruction and received into the Ark of Christ's Church; and being steadfast in faith, joyful through hope, and rooted in love, they may pass through the turbulent floods of this troublesome world and come into the land of everlasting life, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

THANKSGIVING OVER THE WATER

Celebrant: The Lord be with you. People: And with your spirit.

Celebrant: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

People: It is right and just so to do.

Celebrant: We thank You, Almighty God, for the gift of water. Over it the Holy Spirit moved in the beginning of creation. Through it You led the children of Israel out of their bondage in Egypt into the land of promise. In it your Son Jesus received the baptism of John in the River Jordan when the Holy Spirit descended upon Him as a dove. We thank You, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in his death. By it we share in his resurrection. Through it we are reborn by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to your Son, we bring into his fellowship those who come to Him in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Here the Celebrant touches the water and says

Now, Father, sanctify this water by the power of your Holy Spirit. May all who are baptized here be cleansed from sin, be born again, and continue forever in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Savior. To Him, to You, and to the Holy Spirit, be all honor and glory, now and forever. Amen.

THE BAPTISM OF EACH CANDIDATE

Then the Celebrant immerses the candidate or pours water upon the candidate three times, saying: N, I baptize you in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

The Celebrant makes the sign of the Cross upon the forehead of the newly baptized, saying: N, receive the sign of the Cross as a token of your new life in Christ, in which you shall not be ashamed to confess the faith of Christ crucified, to fight bravely under his banner against the world, the flesh, and the devil, and to continue as his faithful servant to the end of your days. Amen.

People: We receive you into the fellowship of the Church. Confess the faith of Christ crucified, proclaim his resurrection, and share with us in the royal priesthood of all his people.

Celebrant: Let us welcome the newly baptized.
